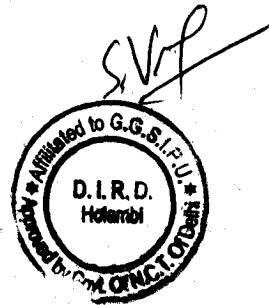

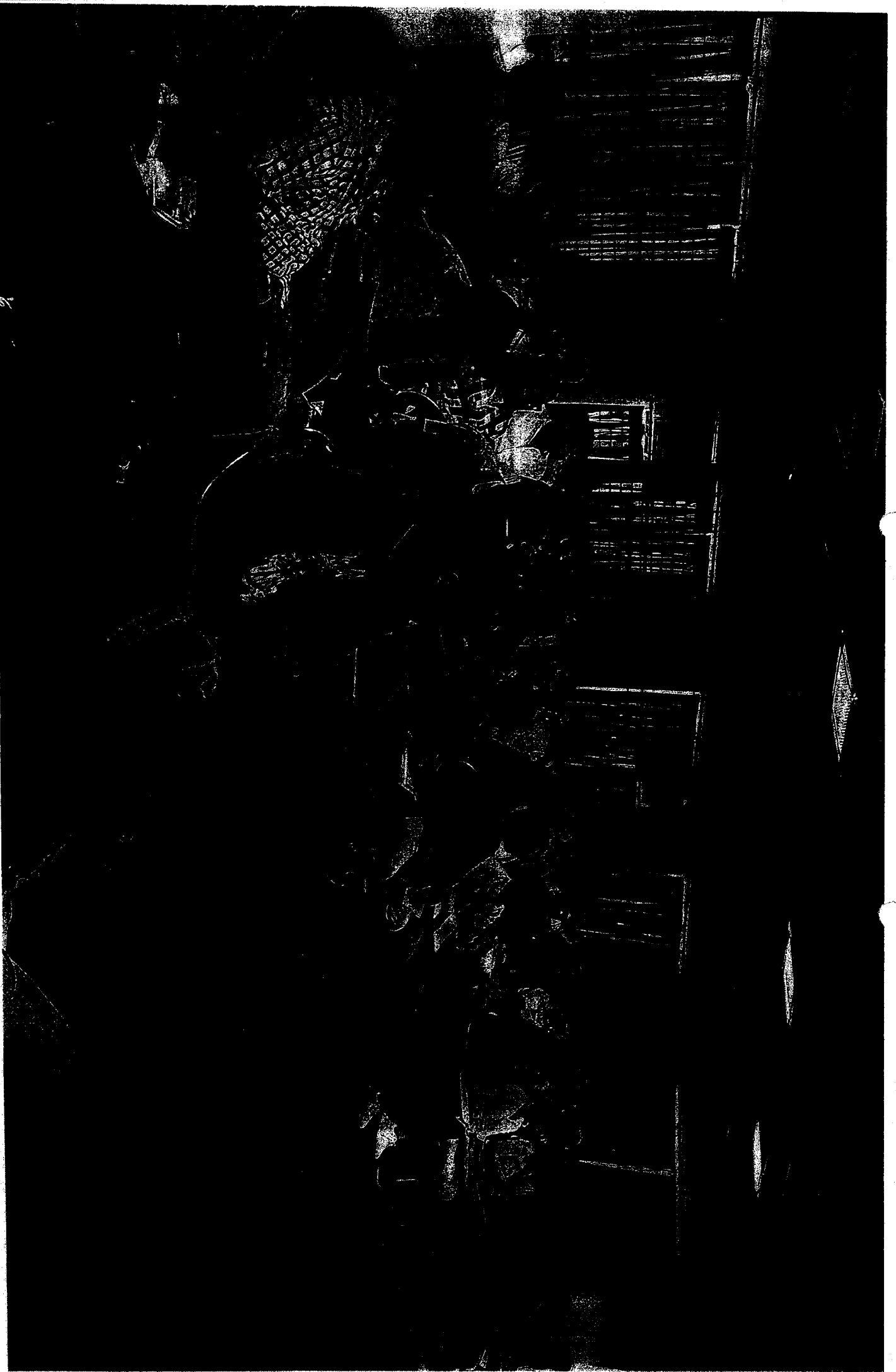
## REPORT

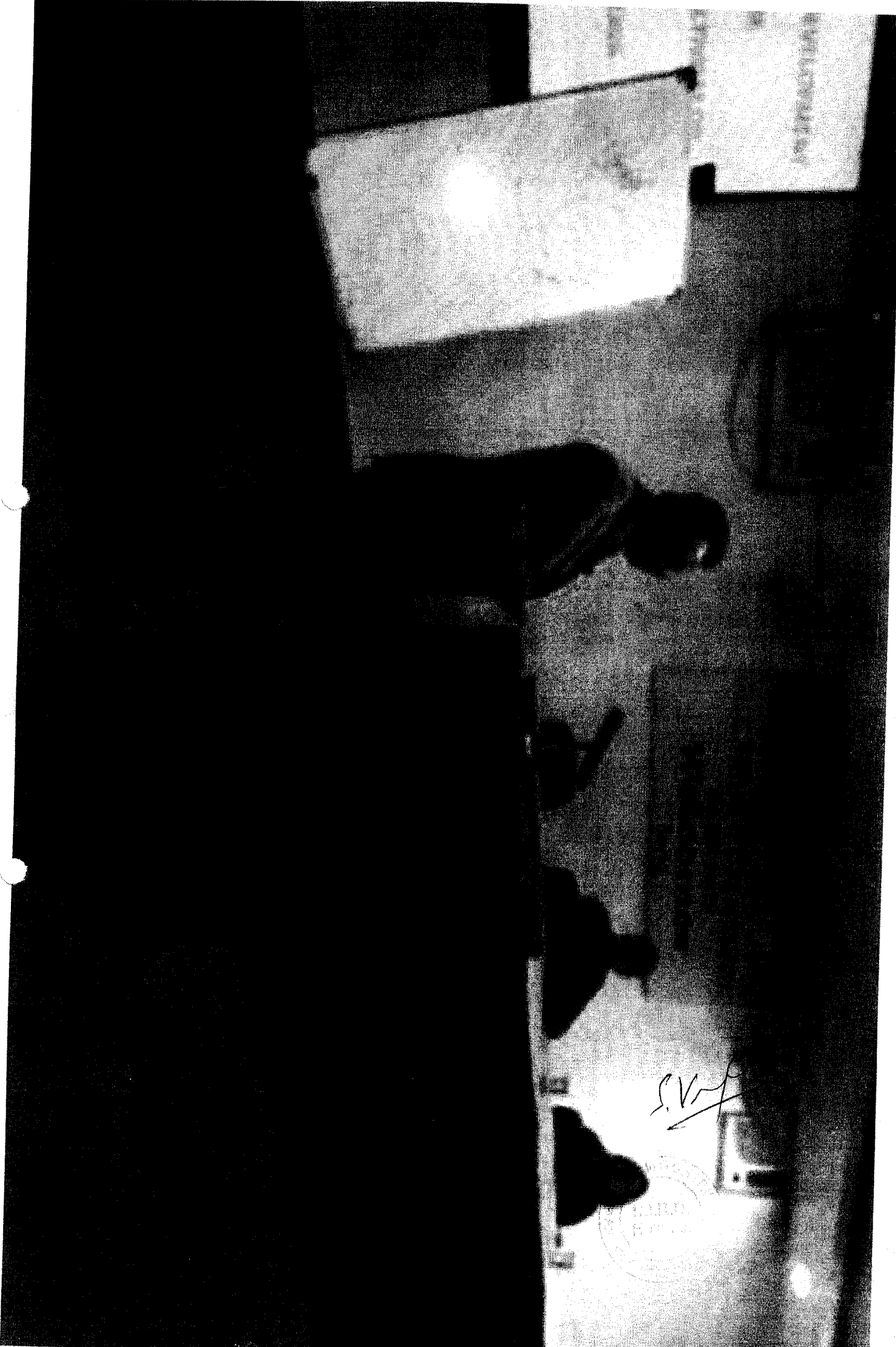
## REPORT

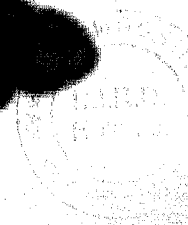



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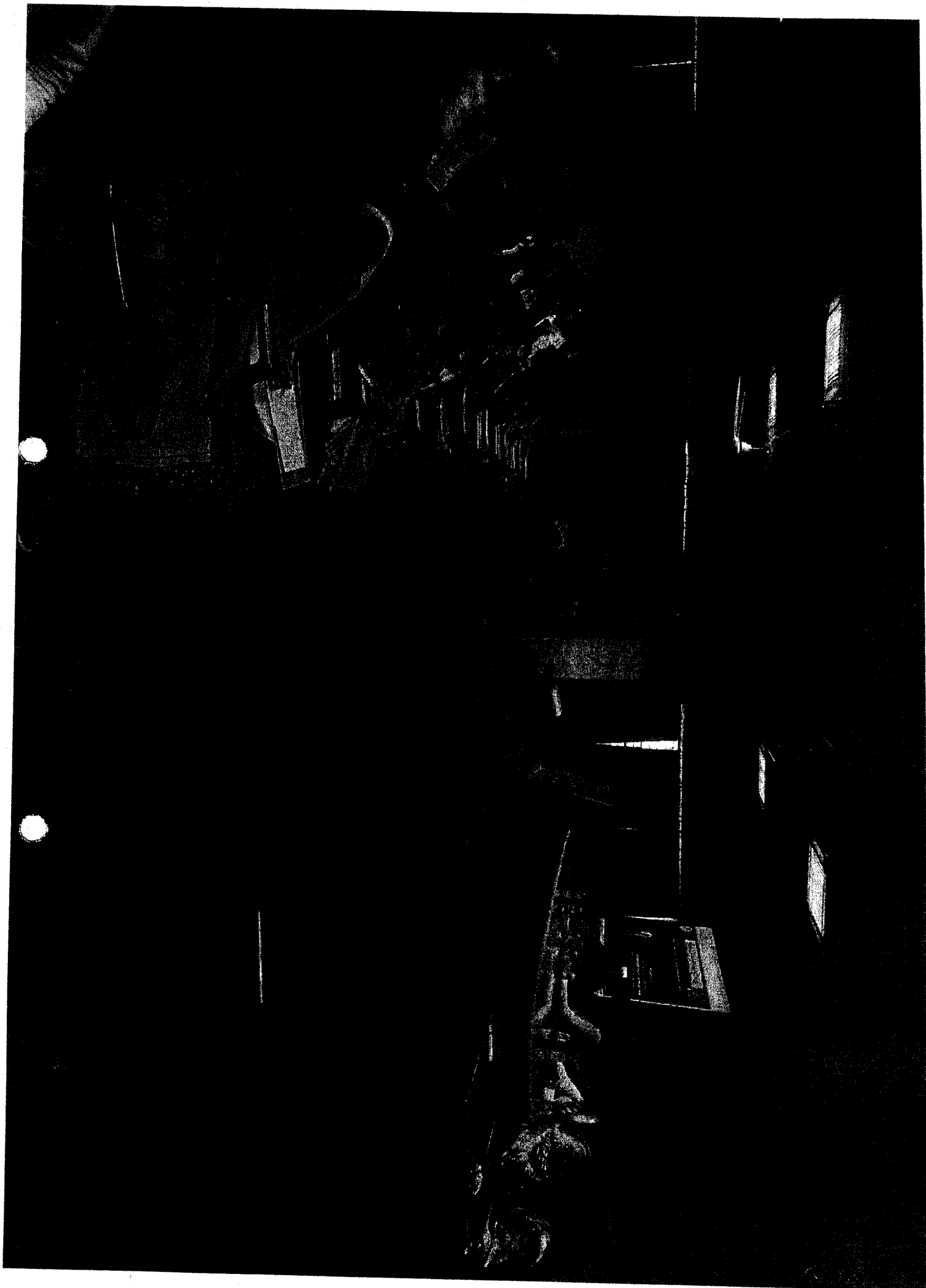
## REPORT

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

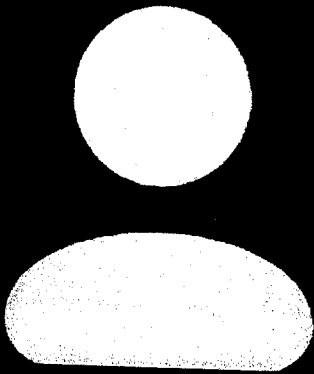
## REPORT


Our College has organized The Health Awareness Programme on topic "Dengue; symptoms and its Preventions" on **12-04-2022 in Seminar Hall.**

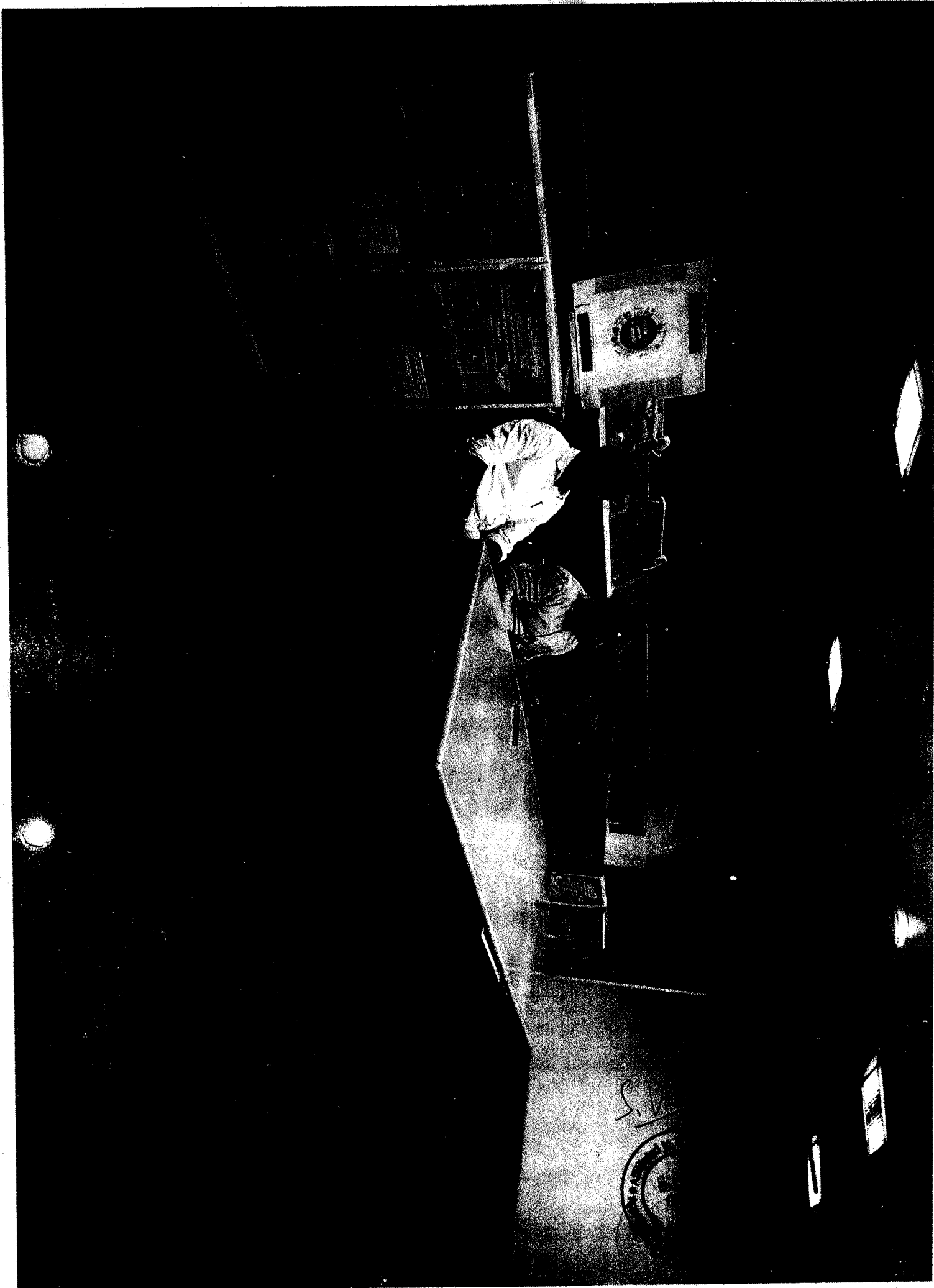
1. Wearing long sleeves cloth.








## REPORT

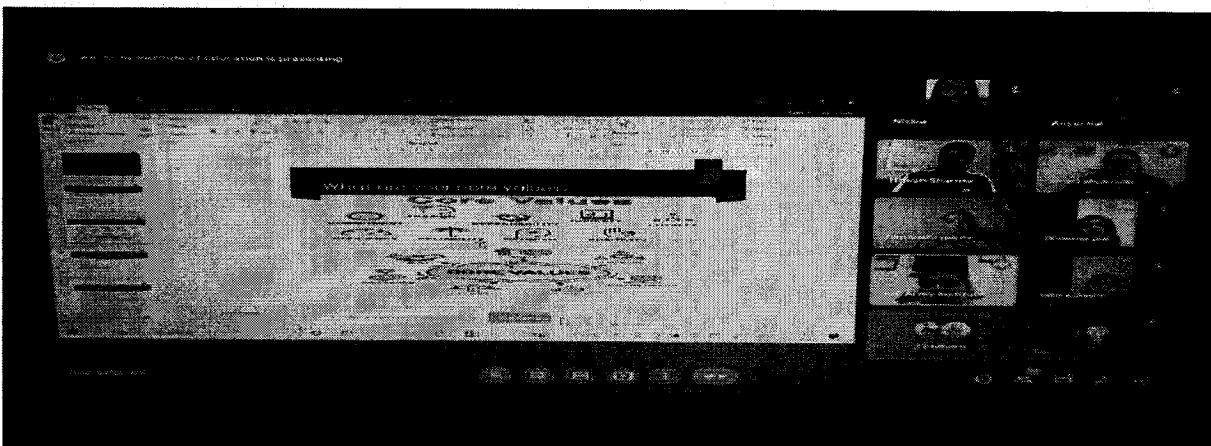
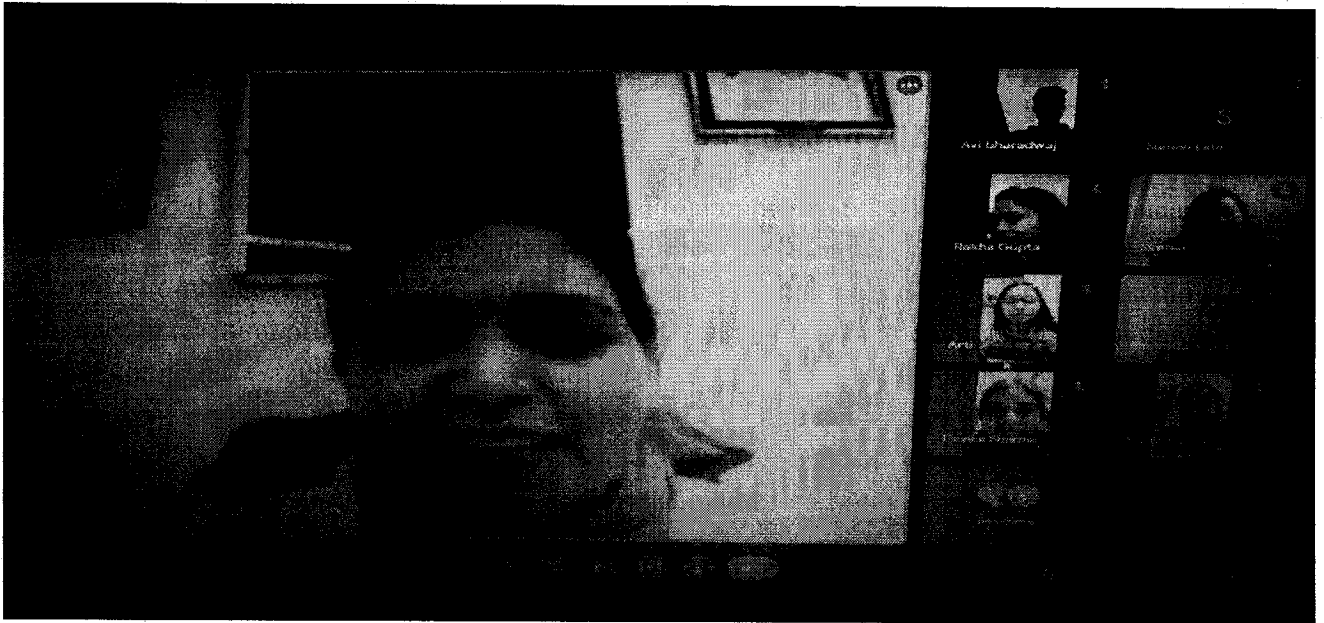
## Faculty Development Programme on “Innovative Ways of Teaching Learning Methodologies & Strategies”
