MOCK INTERVIEW/ ROLE PLAY


- 1. A Mock Interview by Dr. Archana Sinha, a retired Session Judge, was organized on 12th September, 2022.



DEBATE AND QUIZ COMPETITION


- 1. A Quiz Competition on Constitutional and Contract Law for the students of BBA.LLB and BA.LLB was organized on 23rd November, 2022..


